



Locations at MIT are represented by a building number, then a hyphen, then a room number. For example, “2-105” indicates building 2, room 105.

A campus map may be viewed online/on smartphones at map.mit.edu or via the official MIT Mobile app, available for Android and iOS.

Check-in, coach and event supervisor hospitality room (free lunch for coaches and event supervisors), tournament headquarters, scoring/tabulation, first aid, and arbitration are located in 10-105 (Bush Room). Buildings in which event rooms or homerooms are located are circled in red on the above map.

Buses should drop students off on Amherst Street, then teams should enter MIT through building 7 (77 Massachusetts Avenue) and proceed directly to their homerooms. One coach from each team must check in at 10-105 no later than 8:00 a.m. Impound is located at respective event locations and closes promptly at 8:30 a.m.

Forensics is located in building N52, two blocks north on Massachusetts Avenue. Students may walk to N52 on their own, or may meet a member of the tournament staff in the lobby of building 7 at 8:20, 9:35, 10:50, 12:05, 1:20, or 2:35 (10 minutes before the start of each event period) to walk to building N52 together.

The awards ceremony will begin at 7:00 p.m. in Kresge Auditorium, W16-109. Doors open at 6:30 p.m.; please be seated by 6:55 p.m. so that the awards ceremony can start on time. Overflow seating is available in W16-035. After the awards ceremony, buses should pick up students on Amherst Street.
