



Locations at MIT are represented by a building number, then a hyphen, then a room number. For example, “2-105” indicates building 2, room 105.

A campus map may be viewed online/on smartphones at [map.mit.edu](http://map.mit.edu) or via the official MIT Mobile app, available for Android and iOS.

Check-in, coach and event supervisor hospitality room (free lunch for coaches and event supervisors), tournament headquarters, scoring/tabulation, first aid, and arbitration are located in 26-152. Buildings in which event rooms or homerooms are located are circled in red on the above map.
